The community of Coto de Caza was developed nearly 50 years ago as a hunting lodge and has grown into a close-knit community of 4,000 homes and about 15,000 residents. We're proud and protective of our quality of life and many of us believe it would suffer, were it not for the convenience provided by the 241 Toll Road.

For nearly two decades, Coto residents have tracked the efforts of the Transportation Corridor Agencies (TCA) to complete the 241 Toll Road, which would provide Coto residents with improved south-bound mobility options. The Coto De Caza Planning Advisory Committee is pleased to hear that the TCA has begun discussions with the public on ideas to complete this much-needed leg of the Toll Road system.

TCA representatives made a presentation to our Committee and the public at our meeting on July 5. Thereafter, we voted unanimously to support TCA's current public process.
